C&G’s Huian Waste-to-Energy plant Clean Development Mechanism project was successfully registered in the United Nations

The Board of Directors of C&G Environmental Protection Holdings Limited (“C&G” or the “Group”) is pleased to announce that its Huian Waste-to-Energy (“WTE”) plant (“Huian Plant”) located in Fujian Province was successfully registered as a clean development mechanism (“CDM”) project (Code 5828) by the United Nations on 13 September 2012.

Being approved as a CDM project by the United Nations allows Huian Plant to implement the sale of certified emission reduction (CER) credits. The CER credits, also known as carbon credits, each equivalent to one tonne of carbon dioxide, can be traded, sold, and used by industrialised countries to meet a part of their emission reduction targets under the Kyoto Protocol.

The Group’s CER credits will be permitted to transfer to four buyers in Finland with whom the Group has entered into agreement: Fine Carbon Fund KY, Nordic Carbon Fund KY, GreenStream Network Plc and Fine Post-2012 Carbon Fund Ky, which are authorized by the Government of Finland up to 1,370,000 tons of carbon dioxide equivalent.
